2018 City of Gainesville Runoff Election Sample Ballots to Be Mailed

GAINESVILLE, Fla. (April 13, 2018) — Sample ballots for the 2018 City of Gainesville Runoff Election, which will be held May 1, will be mailed April 16.

The sample ballot includes the candidates for District 1, as well as a list of precincts and polling locations within the district. Information on early voting, vote-by-mail ballots, Election Day voting and other elections-related subjects is included in the sample ballot mailer.

Only registered voters who reside within District 1 of Gainesville's city limits are able to vote in this election.
